

SAFMA facilitates SKILL UPGRDATION TRAINING & Making of Tapestry of Heathrow Airport, London

SAFMA coordinated a wonderful opportunity for the women of Jheemarpura, North West Delhi to challenge themselves to learn new skills, thereby preparing themselves to take on more remunerative work in the future.

A unique proposal was made by Prof Ben Stringer, Dept. of Architecture, Westminster University - for the women to make a Tapestry depicting the basic outlines of Heathrow Airport for an Exhibition in London on 16 June 2016.

The tapestry captures the essence of Indian craftsmanship by using different embroidery methods and was prepared with the help of a designer and master craftsman.

The women officially presented the completed tapestry to their Member of Parliament Dr Udit Raj on 30th May 2016 and were awarded Certificates of Appreciation.
